### Description

BSEL is one of Berlin's largest universities of applied sciences. It has over 150 partnerships with other institutions worldwide. Erasmus students pay a 'semester fee' of around EUR250 for registration, student union membership and a public transport pass. The ESN organises social activities such as sightseeing, cocktail nights and museum tours to exchange students each term. BSEL's teaching and assessment is rigorous and UWE Bristol will only consider applications from students who have performed well in their first year.

### Surrounding Area

Berlin is major metropolis offering a wealth of opportunities for learning and leisure. Famously divided in the aftermath of World War Two, Berlin is now well known for its festivals, diverse architecture, nightlife, contemporary arts, public transportation networks, and high standard of living. Berlin is a perfect location for travel to other European destinations.



### Accommodation

BSEL's International Office provide guidance and support in finding accommodation through Studentenwerk Berlin or Studentendorf ("student village") Schlachtensee. Expect to pay EUR230-380/month.

### How to apply

When successfully selected by UWE and nominated to BSEL, you will need to complete an online application, submitting with it a transcript of records, learning agreement, proof of medical insurance (EHIC) and passport photo.
