

Description

Tec de Monterrey is the first Business School in Latin America to win the 'Triple Crown' accreditation: AACSB (USA), EQUIS (Europe) and AMBA (UK). It is a private university with multiple campuses across Mexico, but it's Monterrey campus remains as its flagship with a library, swimming pool, gym, research labs and cafeterias.

Surrounding Area

Monterrey is Mexico's leading industrial city and third largest overall which is home to more than 4 million inhabitants. It is a vibrant and bustling place with museums, art galleries, music venues and theatres, tourist and shopping centres, ecological parks, and more than 80 public and private sport centres. It is considered one of the safest cities in Mexico and is home to a large student population from all over the world.

Accommodation

Whilst Tec does have accommodation available for incoming exchange students, there are also the options for homestay and private accommodation available to students.

When successfully nominated to Tec you will need to fill out an online application and submit a copy of your passport

Visas & Immigration
