

SQL*Plus On Oracle

SQL*Plus is a command line interface into Oracle and it is the user application that ships with the Oracle database. In CSCT & EDM it is available on both the Windows and Unix systems.

Using SQL*Plus On The Windows System

1. From **Start**, select **All Programs, Oracle, SQL*Plus**. A command window will appear.
2. Enter your username@otis, e.g. an-other@otis followed by your password. SQL*Plus for Oracle will now open.

Using SQL*Plus On The Unix System

1. From a command line, type **sqlplus**.
2. Enter your Oracle username and password. SQL*Plus for Oracle will now open.
